Services

Our Core Services are represented by our Services: BEST Courses, European BEST Engineering Competition, BEST Career Day, BEST Career Centre and BEST Symposia on Education.



BEST Courses are academic events where around 25 students from all around Europe gather together to learn about STEM related topics, develop soft and entrepreneurial skills, improve their curricula, and adquire an international mindset.



The European BEST Engineering Competition (EBEC) is organised in a pyramid structure, composed by Local, National or Regional, and Final Rounds where students are able to challenge themselves and acquire skills such as teamwork, communication and critical thinking.



BEST Symposia on Education (BSE) will be described in the section "Collaboration opportunities".



BEST Career Day (BCD) is an European career fair which gives students the opportunity to meet companies and universities.



BEST Career Centre (BCC) is an online career-oriented set of tools that enables STEM students and recent graduates to interact with their future employers, both universities and companies.

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Educational Involvement

Education is a continuous process of development which involves several actors; as an organisation run by students and working for students, educational matters are very important for us.

Through the Educational Involvement Department, BEST strives to gather students' ideas on what can be changed in their universities and to debate topics of interest in European Higher Education.

The department contributes to our mission, developing students, by increasing the awareness on STEM education, gathering students' opinion and disseminating their input to the relevant stakeholders.

The results of the surveys define the main issues to tackle during the BEST Symposia on Education (BSE), where around 25 students from all over Europe are gathered to discuss and propose solutions about the defined topics.

Collaboration Opportunities

Gathering Students' Input

BEST gathers quantitative data regarding Engineering Education issues through surveys, which are shared with our network and partners across Europe. These surveys can be highly customised, target different student groups from BEST network and fulfill different purposes.

Educational Workshops are events that are usually organised during BEST General Meetings with the purpose of gaining a deeper knowledge by solving case studies related to Engineering Education.

Past examples include topics such as "Education for Sustainable Development" and "Student Involvement in Higher Education Institutions".

BEST Symposia on Education

A BEST Symposium on Education (BSE) is an event where students, local and international professors, experts from higher education institutions and companies discuss educational matters and collect input from technology students so that the outcomes of the event can have an impact, helping to shape the educational system both locally and at European level.
